- Age restrictions are strictly enforced—only children who are the age listed for the camp will be allowed to attend.

Students will spend this camp learning about the body systems of a fetal pig. Students will receive in-depth information about the body systems. The first day will involve the integumentary and muscular systems of the body. The skeletal, respiratory, and circulatory systems will be explored on day two. Finally, the digestive and reproductive systems will be covered. Students will learn how these body systems are similar to ours and some of the health and fitness issues that concern each of these systems in our bodies.
